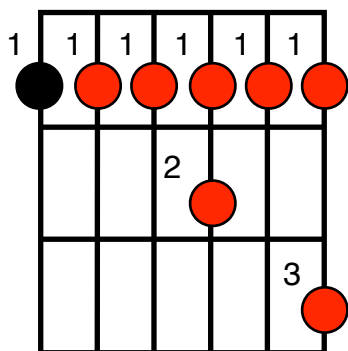

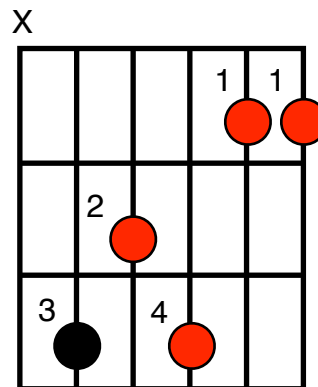

The chords above are dominant 11 chords, normally written with just the number 11 after the chord letter name, D11, E11 etc. The root note of the chord is shown by the black dot on both the E and A strings. The table below shows the names of the notes at each fret on both the E and A strings.

The chord spelling of a dominant 11 chord is:- 1 3 5 b7 9 11
