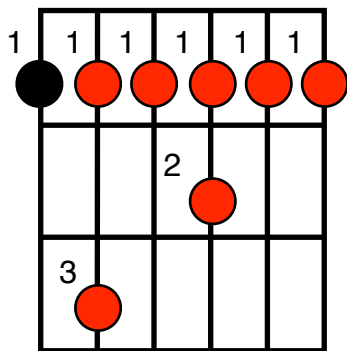

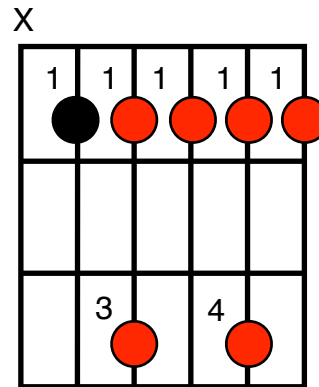

The chords above are dominant 7 chords, normally written with just the number 7 after the chord letter name, D7, E7 etc. The root note of the chord is shown by the black dot on both the E and A strings. The table below shows the names of the notes at each fret on both the E and A strings. It is recommended that you are familiar with the standard major and minor barre chords before moving to these chords.

The chord spelling of a dominant 7 chord is:- 1 3 5 b7.
