These are the chords required for the grade 2 RGT electric guitar exam, in addition to those shown on the preliminary and grade 1 sheets.

Some of these chords require the 1st finger to fret more than one string at a time, this is known as a Half Barre.

The roman numeral [II] shown on the Bm and F#m chords means that these chords are played with the 1st finger at the 2nd fret.
