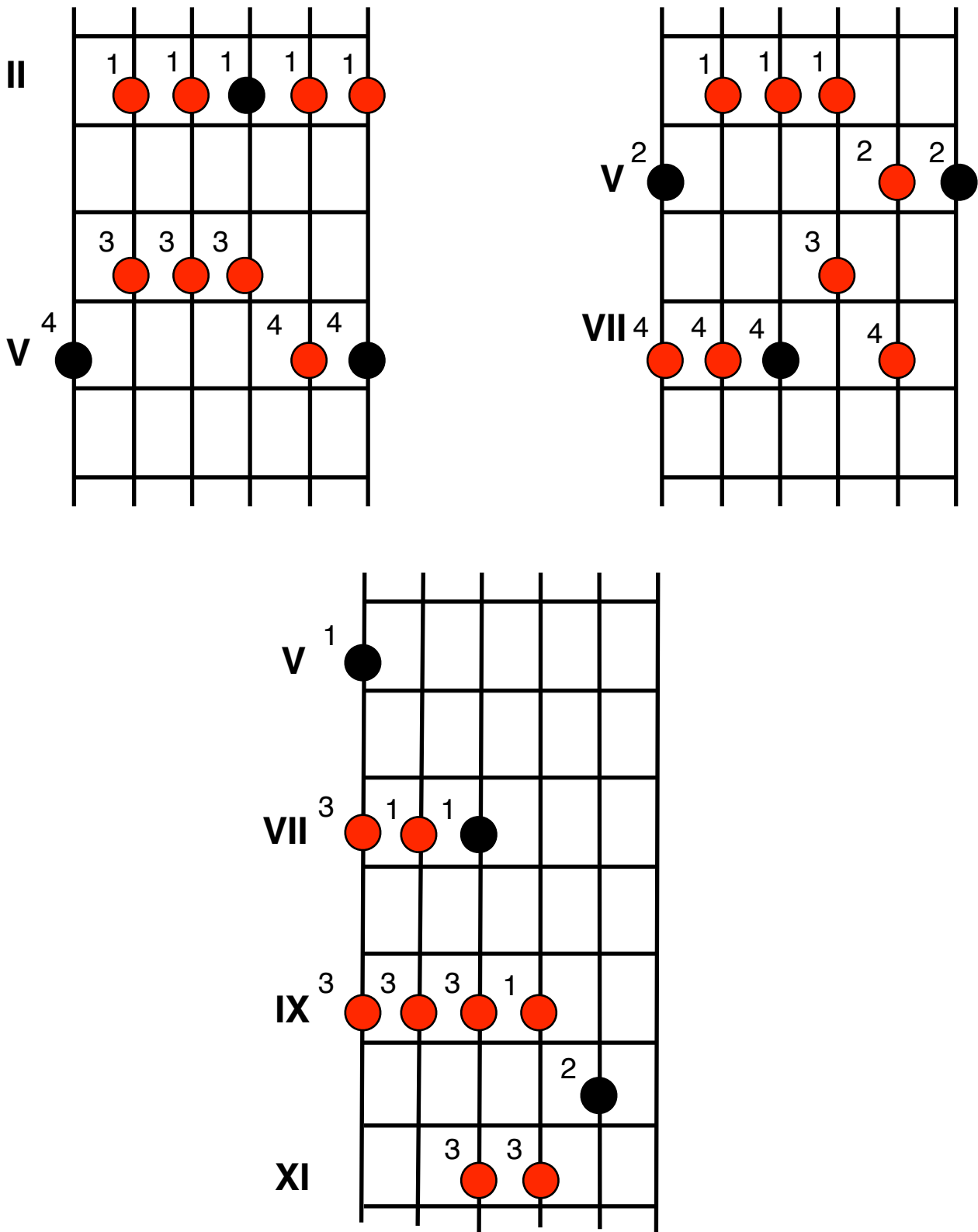


Major Pentatonic 2 Octaves 3 Positions

Above is the A major pentatonic scale shown in 3 positions over 2 octaves. The root notes [in this case A], are shown by the black dots, the other notes in the scale are shown by the red dots. The roman numerals indicate the frets. This scale is transpositional and in grade 5 RGT electric guitar exams, is required in 3 positions in any key over two octaves. The third shape requires position shifts, check the fingering, and is useful for fast runs when soloing.
