
## **Minor 7 Barre Chords**


Root Note E String

The chords above are minor 7 chords, normally written with a lower case m before the number 7, Dm7, Em7 etc. The root note of the chord is shown by the black dot on both the E and A strings. The table below shows the names of the notes at each fret on both the E and A strings. It is recommended that you are familiar with the standard major and minor barre chords before moving to these chords.

The chord spelling of a minor 7 chord is:- 1 b3 5 b7.

In some American publications the minor 7 chord is shown with a minus sign between the chord letter name and the 7:C-7.
