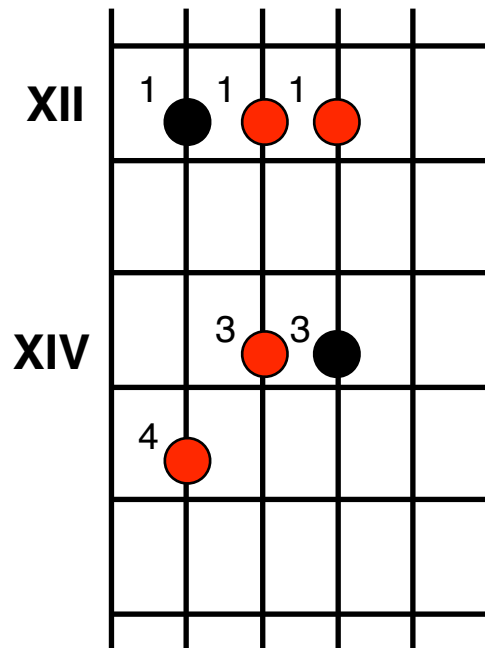
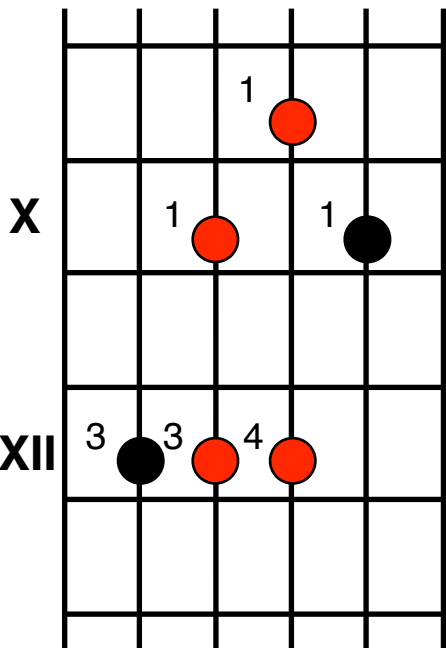
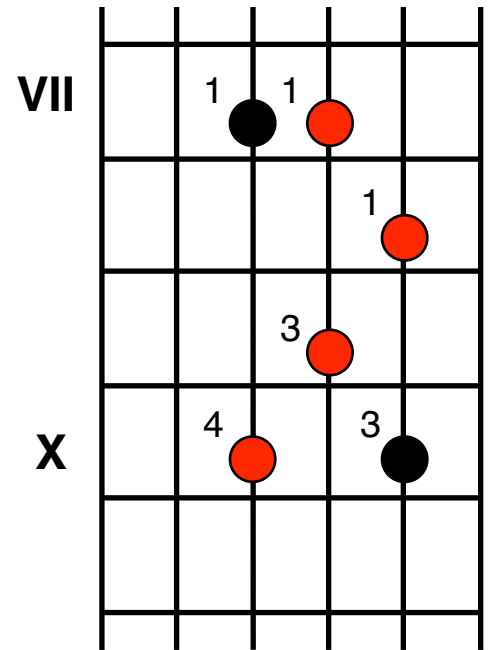
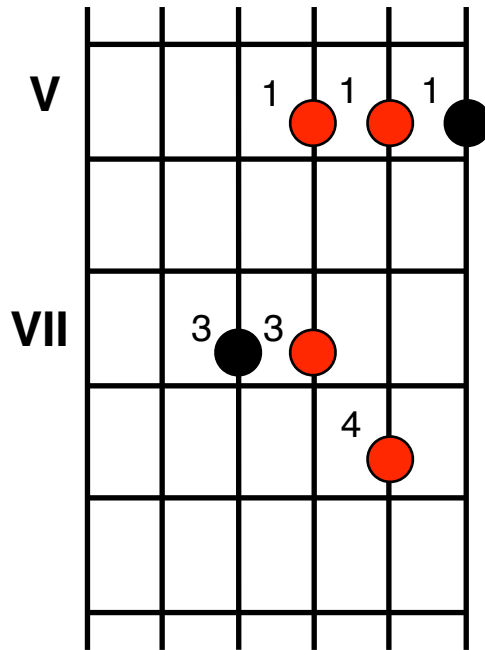
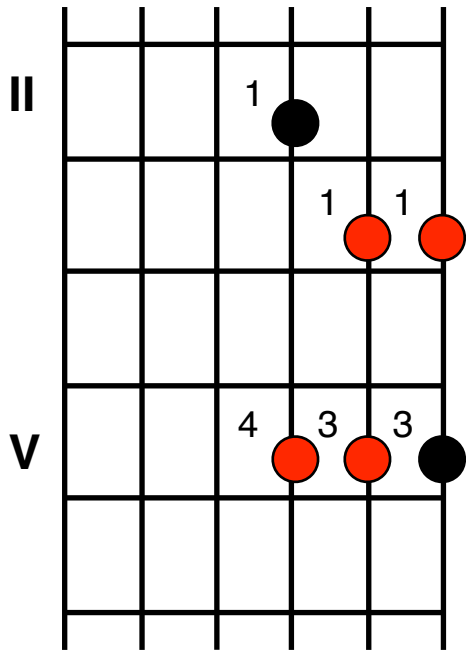


Minor Pentatonic Scale In 5 Positions

Above is the A minor pentatonic scale shown in 5 positions. The root notes [in this case A], are shown by the black dots, the other notes in the scale are shown by the red dots. The roman numerals indicate the frets. This scale is transpositional and at grade 5 RGT electric guitar exams, is required in 5 positions in any key over one octave.
