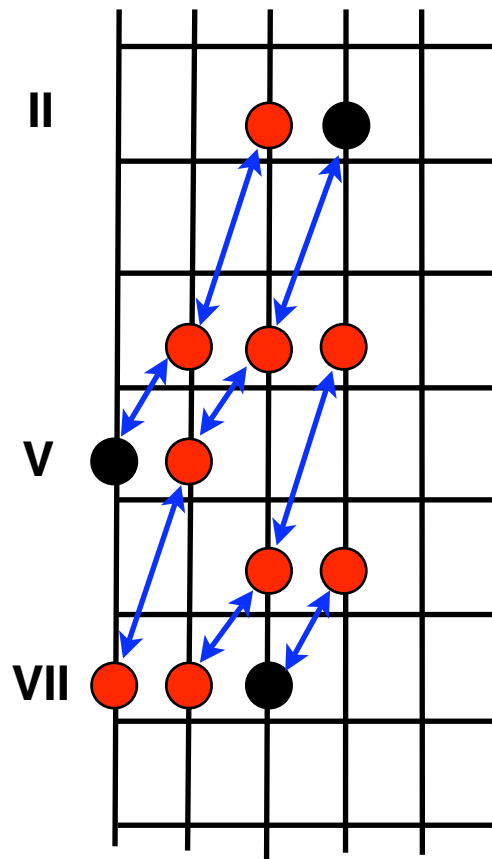


One Octave Major Scale In Harmonised 3rd's

Above is the A major scale in harmonised 3rd's.

The root note is shown in black, the blue arrow shows which two notes to play at the same time. Use the 1st finger to play all the lower notes in each pair, and the 2nd or 3rd fingers for the higher note, depending on whether the note is one or two frets away.

This scale is required in the RGT electric guitar grade 6 exam, in ALL keys.
