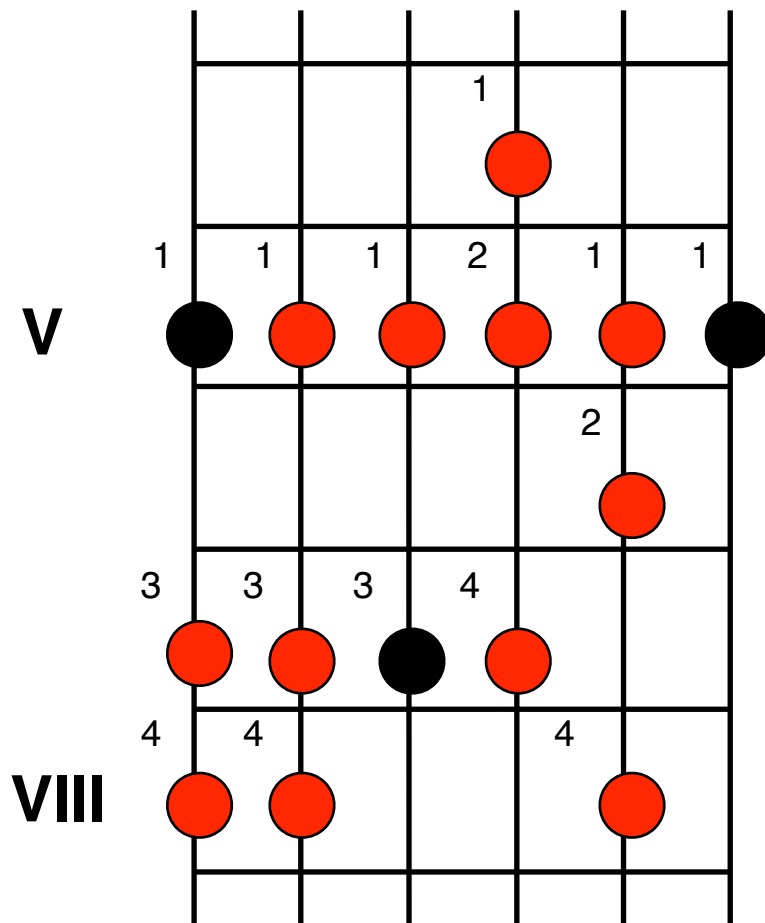


# The Natural Minor Scale

The diagram above shows position 1 of the natural minor scale. This is a very important scale and essential to learn.

The scale shown is the A natural minor scale. The black dots show the root notes [letter name]of the scale, the red dots show the other notes in the scale.

The roman numerals at the side show the fret numbers. This is a movable scale form. The table below shows all the root notes on the E string.

The 'spelling' of the natural minor scale is:- 1 2 b3 4 5 b6 b7 8
