When writing out chords most musicians use a standard method:-

The major chords are written as the letter name only.

The minor chords are written as the letter name followed by a lower case m.

The diminished chords are written as the letter name followed by  $\circ$  or lower case dim. For example:-

Notice that the natural minor chords are the same as their relative major chords they just start on chord VI.
